What is NPO?

"NPO" is an abbreviation for "Non-Profit Organization" or "Not-for-Profit Organization", and is an organization that does not aim to distribute profits to its members by conducting various social contribution activities. Generic name.

Therefore, although it is permissible to conduct business for the purpose of profit, the profit obtained from the business will be used for various social contribution activities.

Of these, corporations that have acquired corporate status (Note) based on the Law for the Promotion of Specified Non-Profit Activities are called "specified non-profit corporations (NPO corporations).

"Regardless of whether they have corporate status, NPOs are expected to play an important role in meeting the diverse needs of society in various fields (welfare, education and culture, community development, environment, international cooperation, etc.).

(Note) Legal status: Anything other than an individual that can be the subject of rights and obligations
